IV C CE (Draw 56 and Draw 9 10)

V D Major DF#A (Draw Holes 234 or Draw Holes 1234)

Gm Minor DG (Blow 34 and 67 and 9 10)

D7 DFmAC (Draw Holes 2-5)

Dm AD (Draw 12)

Am ACE (Draw 456 and 89 10)

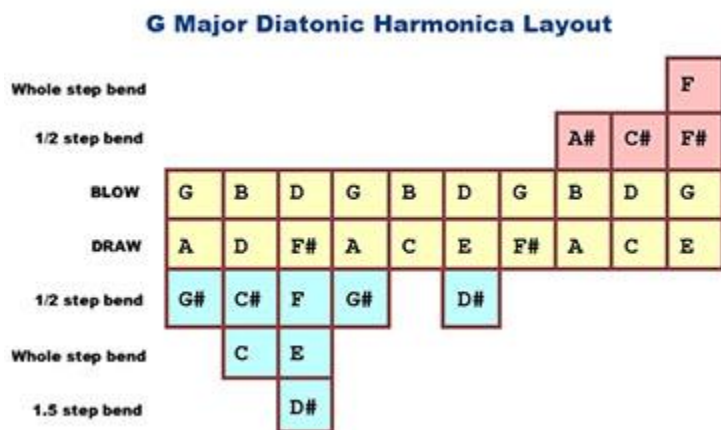
F# FAC (Draw 345 and 789)

Cross Harp 2nd, Play on C Key diatonic harmonica.

G Key is used in Blues for Draw Bending on A D F# A C E.

Key Signature: One Sharp on Top D; G major or E minor.

I play: Hohner Crossover Key of G, Hohner Thunderbird Key Low G.

G 10 Blow hole 10, **G** 1 Blow hole 1, **G** 4 Blow hole 4, **G** 7 Blow hole 7
